CIC Prep Sessions

- We hosted 11 study sessions by teleconference in 2016
- Sessions focus on identifying themes, study tips and going through practice questions together as a group with experienced ICP CIC's and epidemiologists.
- We aim to:
 - Introduce content
 - Stimulate discussion
 - Connect members who are preparing for the exam across a geographically diverse region
- Slide decks that cover one exam module are prepared for each session and posted to our webpage.
- Interesting clarifications and understandings that come from participant discussion are added to the notes section of the PowerPoint and reflected on the webpage for those unable to attend.





CIC Prep Sessions

- Our study sessions serve as a great means to refresh knowledge and engage in discussion about IPAC issues with fellow chapter members.
- We found members who have already written or who do not have immediate intention to write were attending. We continue to promote the sessions to all of our members.
- However, we wanted to better accommodate those actively preparing to write.
- In 2016 we launched the IPAC BC CIC fall study series:
 - Identified which of our 202 members were keen to write and shared emails & locations within so they could reach out to one another as they prepare.
 - Scheduled all 8 study sessions in the Fall (Sept Dec) to better match realistic study timelines
 - Doodle polls to accommodate the schedules of our study group members, then once scheduled opened the sessions up to the whole membership for wider participation
 - Fall scheduling to promote writing earlier in the calendar year (Jan Apr) to make the most of five year CIC term.

In November 2015 we surveyed the IPAC BC membership about the CIC

- We learned we were on the right track with how to support our members to prepare and looked to enhance these efforts with better targeting and scheduling of study sessions in 2016
- We also identified important financial barriers to becoming certified in BC. In 2016, we brought the issue to the provincial IPAC Directors meeting, engaged in chapter discussion about the BC nurses union qualification differentials, and advocated for financial support for CIC.

Having won the CIC Chapter Achievement award in 2016, we were able to offer CIC support funding for the first time to our members!

We focused our financial support on those newly certified members who were not supported by their employers to write, evenly distributing our \$750 award among 5 qualifying members.

We advocated with IPAC BC membership & executive to ear mark funds for 2017 to allow for ongoing financial support. We are currently working on developing an application process recognizing the lack of local financial support and large degree of interest among our members.
